

THE HUMBOLDT PRIZE of Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin - 2019 -

In keeping with a good tradition, Humboldt-Universität will award its annual Humboldt Prize for outstanding scientific results by students and doctoral students of our university.

The Prize is awarded for the best thesis completed as part of the following degree programs:

- Bachelor's Degree - 750 €
- Master's Degree, State Exam - 1.500 €
- Doctoral Degree - 3.000 €

Works which particularly concern issues in „Judaism“ or “Anti-Semitism“ are eligible for an annual special prize. All members of Humboldt-Universität are eligible for this prize, which includes an award amount of 2.000 €.

Only Deans of faculties may nominate the potential prize recipients.

Application materials as PDF in two files (max. 10 MB) partitioned as follows:

1. the work itself, which must have been completed after the application deadline of the previous year,
2. at least two expert evaluations,
 - a curriculum vitae including a list of publications,
 - a recommendation from the faculty's Dean,
 - a copy of the graduation certificate (Abschlusszeugnis) or the doctoral certificate,
 - a short and comprehensible summary about the relevance of the work in the scientific and transdisciplinary context

Deadline: **01st July 2019**
